Certified Nursing Assistants (CNA) help with bathing, dressing and light housekeeping such as bedmaking.



MEDICAL SOCIAL WORKER

MSWs are specially trained to help families manage concerns and organize resources for a variety of needs.

Non-denominational support for people of all faiths to bring peace and comfort.

OUR CARE PROGRAMS

PALLIATIVE CARE, when covered by insurance, provides in-home team support at the same time as curative treatments. Visit frequency and care team members vary by insurer.

★ **FOCUSED CARE PROGRAMS** Care Partners' unique Focused Care Programs are designed for hospice-eligible people who want to live as well as they can, for as long as they can. Each of the four programs is customized for heart failure, chronic lung disease, cancer and dementia. Diet, medications and activities are managed to keep symptoms under control with input from specialists, including occupational and respiratory therapists. Music and art therapy are also available.

TRADITIONAL HOSPICE (Comfort Care) is always available on our service.

DID YOU KNOW

Hospice care providers are reimbursed by a flat daily fee—about \$195 for standard in-home care in the Portland area, regardless of diagnosis or care needs. **Nonprofit hospices have been documented to provide more care in national studies.**
